Wearing a mask – Simplified illustrated version

Steps in pictures: Using a mask

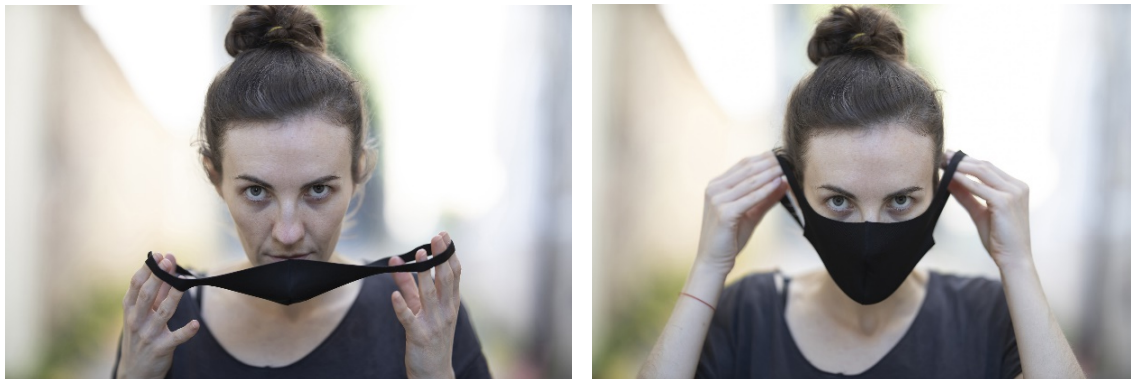
1. Wash my hands with soap and water.



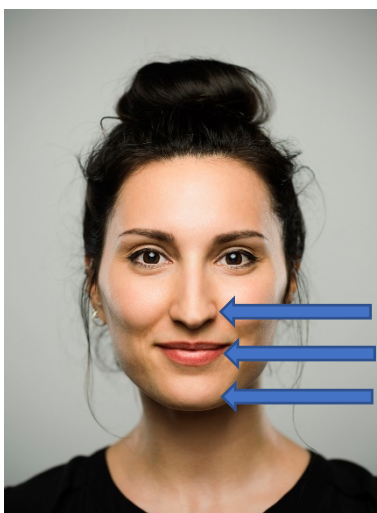
2. Take my clean mask.



3. Put on my mask by holding the elastic ends.



4. Put the mask on to cover my nose and mouth and to fit under my chin.



5. Wash my hands after putting on my mask.



GREAT! I put my mask on the right way.

Instructions for using my mask

- ✓ Change my mask if it is damp, dirty or broken.



- ✗ Do not leave the mask around my neck or hanging off an ear.



✓ I keep my mask on my face and I try not to touch it.



✓ If I touch my mask, I wash my hands.

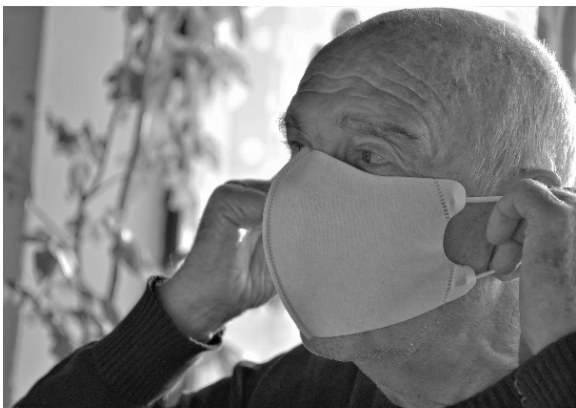


Steps in pictures: Taking off my mask

1. Wash my hands with soap and water.



2. Take the elastic ends (or the strings) without touching the front of my mask.



3. Only hold the elastic ends (or strings) of my mask.



4. Put my mask in a clean bag or container.

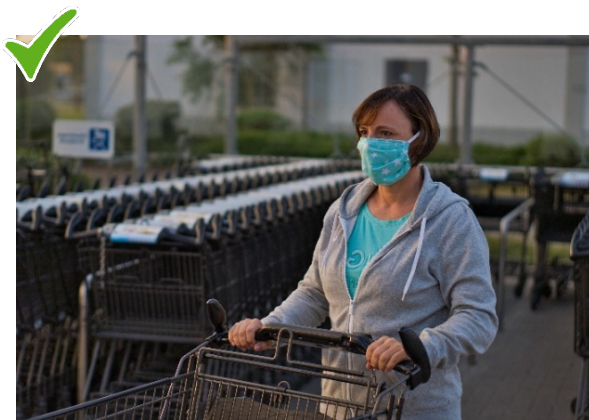


5. Wash my mask with the rest of the laundry when I get home.
